

DBMAT Intervener Scholarship Application

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in applying for this scholarship. These funds have been raised and set aside by DBMAT www.dbmat-tx.org. These funds are used specifically for the education of individuals working with people who are deafblind.

The recipient of this scholarship will be able to apply to the following course available on-line:

• Central Michigan University (https://www.cmich.edu/program/deafblind-intervener).

The deafblind training program includes multiple courses for an equivalent of 12 college credit hours. Upon successful completion you would be eligible to apply to be a credentialed Intervener. (For more information see www.intervener.org.)

In order to be considered for the Intervener scholarship, please address the following:

1. If you work with a school district or provider we ask them to consider sharing in the cost of your training. The number and the amount awarded for the scholarships will be based on limited funds raised by DBMAT volunteers. We require that you submit our template letter to your employer and provide the response with your application.

Note: There is value in your sharing with your employer about the importance of this training, along with the positive impact it can make on a deafblind child or adult and those around them. Our goal is for the employer to share the financial responsibility and thus <u>support you</u> in this training. When employers are invested in this process we have seen a positive outcome for the deafblind individuals, Interveners and the Team around them.

- 2. Recipients of the intervener scholarship MUST be a member of DBMAT in good standing. You can become a member of DBMAT by going to the DBMAT website membership page, and signing up. http://www.dbmat-tx.org/member/member.html
- 3. Live/work in the state of Texas.
- 4. Agree to work in the area of deafblindness for a minimum of two years.
- 5. Although not mandatory, we encourage the parents/guardians of the child/adult to become members of DBMAT. By being involved in this support organization families will be supported by both other families and professionals in the deafblind community. It is also a proven fact that the successes of the deafblind individual can be attributed to the relationships that are developed and nurtured between their home, school, and Community life, which this organization will help families learn about.
- 6. After applications are received and reviewed, you will be notified, and a phone interview will be scheduled.
- 7. Applications for this SCHOLARSHIP will be accepted throughout the year; however, those received by April 15th will be announced by end of May each year.
- 8. Please remember that you MUST have access to a computer to take these courses.
